You Must Always Have Your Blue Key Paddle with you for ID purposes. Without it, you will be asked to leave the pool!

The pool areas are for owners, residents & their accompanied guests, & houseguests only. Residents shall have no more than 6 people (including the owner or resident) using the pool at any time. Pool areas cannot be reserved for exclusive use of a private party, meeting or social gathering.

Summer has arrived and the kids will be getting out of school soon. Please be alert for children playing in our neighborhood. The legal speed limit is 25 mph, but 15-20 mph is a much safer speed for our community.

**As a reminder...please notify the HOA office if you see any sprinklers throughout the community that are broken or running. This helps the HOA significantly conserve on water costs. Thank you for your help in this matter.**

Any owner leasing or renting his/her Condominium shall provide the office with a current completed Lease Addendum Form .

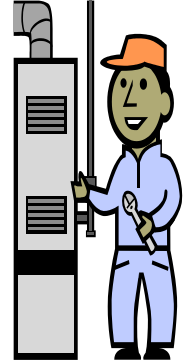


**Attention Playmor Residents:

## IMPORTANT INSURANCE INFORMATION

### FOR HOMEOWNERS:

**All homeowners need to carry an insurance policy for their interior contents. The HOA's insurance does not cover interior additions, personal property, loss of use, earthquake, flood, or personal unit owner's liability. Please consult with your own insurance agent to ensure that your personal insurance integrates with the association's coverage in all respects, including protection for the HOA's deductible. If you don't have an agent, you may want to contact the HOA's agent Paula Crowder at 951-300-9333.**

HOA fees are due the 1st of each month and considered late after the 15th of each month. Your account will be charged a 10% late fee if received after the 15th.

**Remember to put your 3 digit account number on your check.** Thank you to those of you who already do!
